ARTIGOS SANTO ANTÓNIO INDEXADOS NA PUBMED/MEDLINE EM 2024

A Unidade Local de Saúde de Santo António (ULSSA) manteve, em 2024, uma produção científica de elevado impacto, com um total de 501 publicações indexadas na base de dados PubMed, das quais 244 contaram com autoria principal de profissionais da instituição. Apesar de representar uma ligeira redução de 2% face a 2023, este valor confirma a continuidade de uma trajetória consolidada na investigação científica em saúde (Figura 1).

Das publicações identificadas, 472 foram publicadas em revistas indexadas na MedLine e 471 possuem fator de impacto (FI) atribuído pelo Journal Citation Reports (JCR). Entre estas, 37% encontram-se no primeiro quartil (Q1) da sua respetiva área científica (Figura 2). A soma total do FI das publicações atingiu 1707,2, destacando-se 76 artigos com FI superior a 5 e 27 com FI superior a 10.

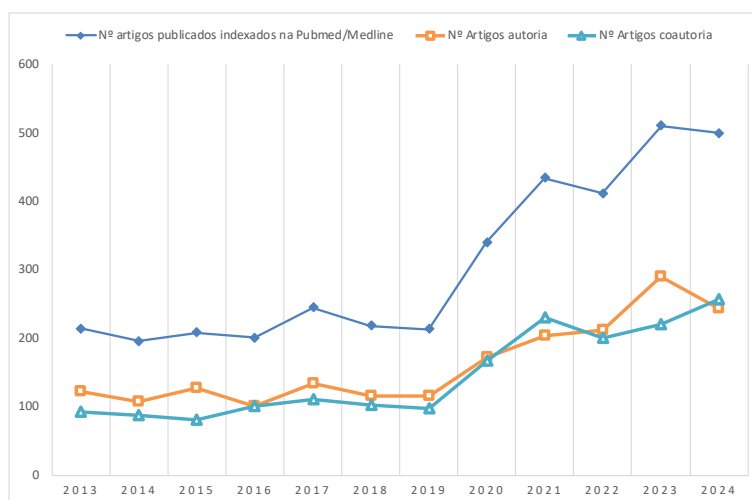


Figura 1 - Número de publicações com afiliação ao Santo António referenciadas na PubMed entre 2013 e 2024, discriminada por autorias e coautorias

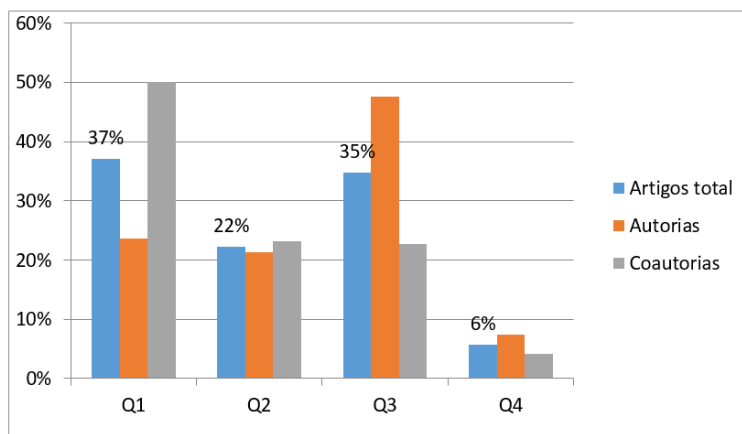


Figura 2 - Artigos JCR 2024 distribuídos por quartis de acordo com autoria e coautoria

A colaboração internacional esteve presente em 34% das publicações, contribuindo com 57% do total do FI, o que reforça a relevância da integração da ULSSA em redes de investigação científica globais.

As parcerias estratégicas com instituições académicas e científicas foram um fator determinante na produção científica da ULSSA. Destaca-se a colaboração com o Instituto de Ciências Biomédicas Abel Salazar (ICBAS), presente em 43% das publicações, seguida da Universidade do Porto (12%) e do Instituto de Investigação e Inovação em Saúde (i3S) (5%).

A adesão à política de ciência aberta é expressiva, com 82% das publicações disponíveis em acesso livre. Este fator favoreceu uma ampla disseminação do conhecimento, refletida em 173 artigos já citados até fevereiro de 2025, totalizando 530 citações, das quais 87% correspondem a publicações em acesso aberto.

No âmbito da translação do conhecimento científico para a prática clínica, os profissionais da ULSSA participaram na elaboração de 9 guidelines e orientações clínicas, reforçando o compromisso da instituição com a melhoria contínua da qualidade dos cuidados de saúde prestados.

Apresenta-se a coletânea de artigos da autoria ou co-autoria dos profissionais da ULSSA publicados em revistas científicas indexadas na Pubmed/Medline em 2024. A denominação é obrigatória e não deverá ser traduzida para inglês ou outras línguas, exceto em revistas que o exijam. Relativamente a denominações abreviadas, poderão ser utilizadas: “Santo António” (expressão preferencial) ou ULS de Santo António (acrónimo facultativo) que deverá ser incorporado no final, entre parêntesis, se as regras de publicação assim o permitirem.
2. As denominações das grandes unidades da Unidade Local são de uso facultativo, não deverão ser traduzidas e grafam-se da seguinte forma:
 - a. Hospital de Santo António (HSA).
 - b. Hospital Magalhães Lemos (HML).
 - c. Centro de Genética Médica Jacinto Magalhães (CGMJM).
 - d. Centro Integrado de Cirurgia de Ambulatório (CICA).
 - e. Centro Materno-Infantil do Norte Albino Aroso (CMIN).
 - f. Agrupamento de Centros de Saúde de Gondomar (ACeS Gondomar).
 - g. Agrupamento de Centros de Saúde do Porto Ocidental (ACeS Porto Ocidental).

A referência aos departamentos, serviços ou unidades são facultativas, podendo ser traduzidas para a língua de redação do manuscrito.

O endereço postal comum é: Largo do Professor Abel Salazar, 4099-001 Porto, Portugal. Não se traduz. O uso do termo “Oporto” é fonte de erros e equívocos nas bases bibliográficas.

O autor deverá adotar uma denominação pessoal uniforme, invariável no que respeita a iniciais, nome, apelidos ou eventual uso de hífen, para que os trabalhos lhe sejam associados de forma inequívoca ao longo da carreira, prevenindo erros na atribuição de autorias pelas bases de dados internacionais. 4. Concordância da responsabilidade na exatidão e integridade de todo o trabalho.

Os autores devem preencher os critérios específicos da autoria, e a sua ordem deve seguir princípios éticos. Não devem ser incluídos autores apenas por inerência dos seus cargos institucionais. Todos os colaboradores que não encaixam nos critérios da autoria devem ser listados na secção “Agradecimentos”.
